

Make-up Expiration Guidelines

Once opened and used you should consider replacing make-up products as follows:

After 1 year of use

Blush
Eye pencil
Eye shadow
Lip balm
Lip gloss
Lip pencil
Lip stick
Loose powder
Pressed powder
Shimmer powder

30-45 Days

Mascara

After 6-8 months of use

Concealer
Foundation, cream
Foundation, liquid

See product expiration date

Cleanser
Moisturizer
Moisturizer with sunscreen
Toner

Healthy make-up use

Above all

Consider your makeup items as personal as your tooth brush, never use anyone else's or allow yours to be used by anyone else.

Whenever possible dispense product to a clean applicator then apply to skin.

After illness or infections;

Discard chapped lip product used just before or during illness, regardless of expiration recommendation

Discard mascara used before or during illness, regardless of expiration recommendation

Clean products monthly;

Clean eye & lip pencil sharpener with an alcohol soaked cotton swab

Wash makeup brushes with mild soap and water

Wipe eye pencil with alcohol & sharpen with clean sharpener

Wipe lip pencil with alcohol & sharpen with clean sharpener

Wipe lipstick with alcohol soaked cotton swab

Wipe stick form, chapped lip product with alcohol, include edges and lid.
